



# North High School's Marine Biology Class

June 24-July 1, 2010

Spend a week in the tropical waters of the Caribbean Sea on the Island of Grand Cayman:

- ❖ Stay in an oceanfront condo with pool
- ❖ Complete 12 to 15 total dives
- ❖ Dive to 100 feet
- ❖ Dive at night
- ❖ 2 boat dives included
- ❖ Stingray city dive (hand-feed them!)
- ❖ Hold a live sea turtle at Turtle Farm
- ❖ Identify over 200 reef creatures
- ❖ Earn 1 credit in Marine Biology



**Training:** We will complete your SCUBA training classes before and during the trip. This is a lifetime certification, allowing you to continue your diving adventures after our trip.

- ❖ SCUBA training begins in February with afternoon classes and evening pool sessions.
- ❖ We will complete before-school Marine Biology classroom sessions in the spring.

**Cost:** \$2300 for first time SCUBA divers, \$2000 for returners. This covers airfare, SCUBA certification, teaching materials, food, lodging, and all equipment rentals.

- ❖ Bring spending money for one brief shopping excursion & food at the airport.
- ❖ Students will need to purchase a snorkel, dive boots, fins, mask, 1 mm thick wetsuit, & a gear bag (package deals available for about \$170)
