

but only one base if the ball goes out of play.

- * Single - When a batter hits the ball and reaches first base without an error
- * Double - When a batter hits the ball and reaches second base without an error.
- * Triple - When a batter hits the ball and reaches third base without an error.
- * Home run - When a batter hits the ball and reaches home without an error.
- * Grand slam - A home run with the bases loaded.

Ground rules

- * The ball must be pitched underhand.
- * At the top of the arch, the pitch must be at least six feet high but not higher than ten feet.
- * Base runners cannot lead off, they must wait until the ball is hit or crosses the plate before they can leave the base.
- * Base runners cannot steal.
- * Batters cannot bunt.
- * Base runners may over run first base without liability of being put out.
- * A base runner may tag up and advance at his/her own risk on a ball that is caught.
- * A base runner is out if hit by a batted ball while off the base and in fair territory.
- * A base runner is out if they interfere with a fielder trying to field a ball.
- * A base runner is out if they run outside of the baseline to avoid being tagged.
- * A base runner is out if they leave the base before the ball is hit or crosses the plate.
- * A base runner is out on a fly ball that is caught and returned to the base before the runner returns.
- * A base runner is out if the ball beats them to the bag on a force out, or if they are tagged by the ball on a non force out.
- * A base runner is safe anytime they are interfered with by a fielder, unless the fielder is fielding the ball.
